This beautiful ruby colored, red wine blend is made from Sangiovese, Zinfandel, and Cabernet Sauvignon. It is rounded and balanced, creating a medley of fig, cherry, and cocoa powder on the palate, with a very smooth finish.

This beautiful merlot has plum on the nose, with notes of cocoa, vanilla, plum, Bing cherry on the palate with a touch of black pepper on the finish.

The wine has a bright, Indian-jewel toned ruby color. The nose has hints of ripe plum and black currant. On the palate, you'll experience a medium-high acidity with notes of plum, black licorice, and cardamom.

This is our very first blend and features three Italian grapes - Sangiovese, Sagrantino, and Teroldego. On the palate you'll taste cranberry, plum sauce, and a bit of cherry, with hints of black cardamom and muddled mint.
