Tasting Notes



This beautiful ruby colored, red wine blend is made from Sangiovese, Zinfandel, and Cabernet Sauvignon. It is rounded and balanced, creating a medley of fig, cherry, and cocoa powder on the palate, with a very smooth finish.

The wine has a bright, Indian-jewel toned ruby color. The nose has hints of ripe plum and black currant. On the palate, you'll experience a medium-high acidity with notes of plum, black licorice, and cardamom.

Our vineyard, Narra Vineyards, was the first to plant the Entav clone of the Tannat grape in Texas, and this is our first vintage of 100% Tannat using this Entav clone.
